




"Lay hands" signify two truths: <sup>1</sup>Identification = we become one with the sacrifice; we confess / repent of our sin (1John 1:9-10); <sup>2</sup>Substitution = transfer our sin / judgement to the sacrifice; it dies, not us (see Isaiah 53:4-6). Never drank or offered alone, the drink offering was made only with the meal offering which accompanied all burnt and peace offerings. It was poured out in the sanctuary (Num. 15:1-10, 28:7).
