

<b>vs</b>	
<b>1</b>	<b>It is not enough to say that Jesus is "a god": that he is godlike or that he is "divine".</b>
<b>2</b>	<b>His deity was from eternity past and without beginning – nor did he somehow become a god after his resurrection.</b>
<b>8</b>	<b>John – a faithful witness to the person of Jesus: not baptism, tongues, healing etc.</b>
<b>9</b>	<b>Also – the light reveals men as they really are.</b>
<b>12</b>	<b>Tells us how we can become sons of God – not by joining a church, being good or moral, or by doing one's best.</b>
<b>13</b>	<b>To become a child in a physical sense, we have to be born. To become a son of God we have to be born again – a 2<sup>nd</sup> time.</b>
	<b>This verse tells us 3 ways the new birth does not take place and the one way by which it does.</b>
<b>17</b>	<b>The Law was not a display of grace – obey or die. The Law told us what was right but did not give the power to obey it.</b>  <b>It was given to show men what God was like and that they were sinners. But it could not save them from the terrible consequences of their sins.</b>
